## Motion To Amend: Current Bumping Practices

- 1. (a) Motion to amend the current Collective Agreements on "Bumping" rights. Any personnel returning to work from either QCTO Training or as a result of disciplinary action taken by the company, will assume a working position as either a Spareboard employee, or forced onto any relevant job deemed essential by the company, for the duration of the change of card, to alleviate the disruption of the workforce, resulting in-
  - (b) the abolishment of the 7 Day Bid, resulting in
  - (c) all vacation temps to be filled by Spareboard employees first.

The only exception to the above clause, is employees returning to work after Vacation while a Change of Card has taken place, and employees returning from injury.

## Motion To Amend: Current Overtime Calling Procedures

1. Overtime by seniority: Motion to amend current collective agreement in regards to calling personnel by seniority. Calling for overtime will be dictated on a rotating cycle, guaranteeing fairness; any individuals on the "Extra Work Board" will be called in order- if overtime is accepted by an individual, the next call for an overtime shift will commence at the very next person, ie if the 15<sup>th</sup> person accepts the first shift, future overtime calls will commence at the 16<sup>th</sup>. Overtime canvassing will be fulfilled on a *first response*, *first commitment basis* regardless of time.
